HOME Program Federal and State regulations

- TDHCA governing statute at Texas Government Code,

- State HOME Rules at 10 Texas Administrative Code Chapters 1, 20, and 23

Single Family HOME Eligible Applicants

- Units of General Local Government (Cities and Counties)
- Councils of Government (COGs)
- Non-profit Organizations (including CHDOs)
- Local Mental Health Authorities (LMHA)
- Public Housing Authorities

- Eligible Single Family HOME activities include:
 - Homeowner Rehabilitation (HRA)
 - Homebuyer Assistance/Rehabilitation (HBAR)
 - Tenant-Based Rental Assistance (TBRA)
 - Contract for Deed Conversion (CFDC)
- HOME funding categories for these activities include:
 - General Set Aside
 - Persons with Disabilities Set Aside
 - Disaster Relief Set Aside
 - Contract for Deed Conversion Set Aside

TDHCA contracts with Administrators through a Reservation System

- Applicants submit applications to become a Reservation System Participant (RSP) Administrators
- Administrative deficiencies must be cured within 5 days
- Applications are processed in the order received
- Agreements have a 24 month term
- RSP agreements do not guarantee availability of funds
- Match is waived for 2013 HOME RSP Administrators

 - Application posted on TDHCA website 12/2/2013
 - Application acceptance period will begin 12/16/2013
 - Applications submitted electronically or via U.S. mail
- NEW: Application is in EXCEL format
 - 2013 HOME Applicants must use the new format
 - If not possible, contact HOME for alternate solution

- Previous WORD version will not be accepted
- Applications submitted to home@tdhca.state.tx.us will not be accepted
- Complete each tab in the application; depending on your entry, other tabs may appear
- Must "Enable Macros" to be able to use the Application

Background and Funding

Because there's no place like HOME.

HOME Funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)

- HUD allocates funding to Participating Jurisdictions (Cities, Counties, States, and Consortiums) throughout the country annually using a pre-determined formula
- State Participating Jurisdictions, such as TDHCA, typically contract with Administrators to administer the program state-wide
- HUD allocates approximately \$24 million of HOME funds to TDHCA annually
 - TDHCA's One-Year Action Plan describes funding plan

 - Remaining General Set Aside funds subject to Regional limits
- 2/11/2014
 - \$2,000,000 added to remaining General Set Aside funds and made available state-wide

Set Asides not Subject to Regional Allocation Formula (RAF) Timelines

- 12/30/2013
 - Set Aside HOME funding made available state-wide
 - \$2,000,000 Contract for Deed
 - \$1,828,497 Single Family PWD (2013 HOME allocation and reallocated MF PWD)
 - \$1,000,000 Disaster Relief

RAF Highlights

- On 12/30/2013, the HOME Reservation Summary screen will display Urban/Rural funding limits by sub-region
 - View the current HTF Amy Young Reservation Summary screen as an example
- Limits will be applied at the activity address level, not based on Administrator's service area
 - Administrators can serve multiple areas and regions
- A table will be posted on the HOME webpage of all Texas cities, Urban/Rural designation, and Region
 - Reservation System will check the activity address for funding availability at the time of set-up submittal
