


Directions to Subrecipients: Follow the steps in order as noted along the left margin.

Subrecipients of all listed programs must use this tool and process to determine Household Eligibility. This guidance from the Department does not modify or amend its Contract with the Subrecipient.

STEP TWO: Check for Documents that Establish Citizenship or Qualified Status for Adult and Children Household Members




³ Early public or private documents are documents that were created and/or issued early in the applicant’s life, preferably in the first five years.



Note: If a household member’s citizenship documentation lists their maiden name instead of their married name, the first name and date of birth on the household member’s identification must match the first name and date of birth on the citizenship document.
