

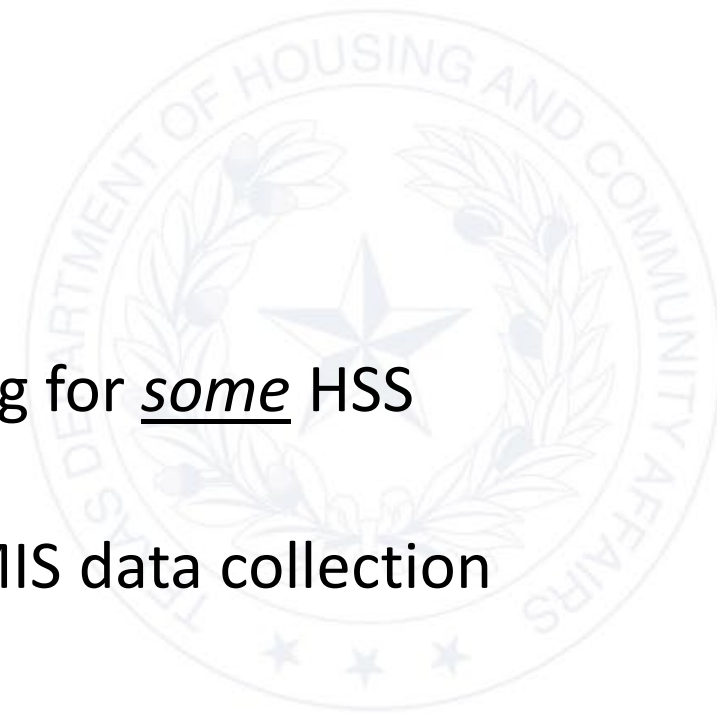


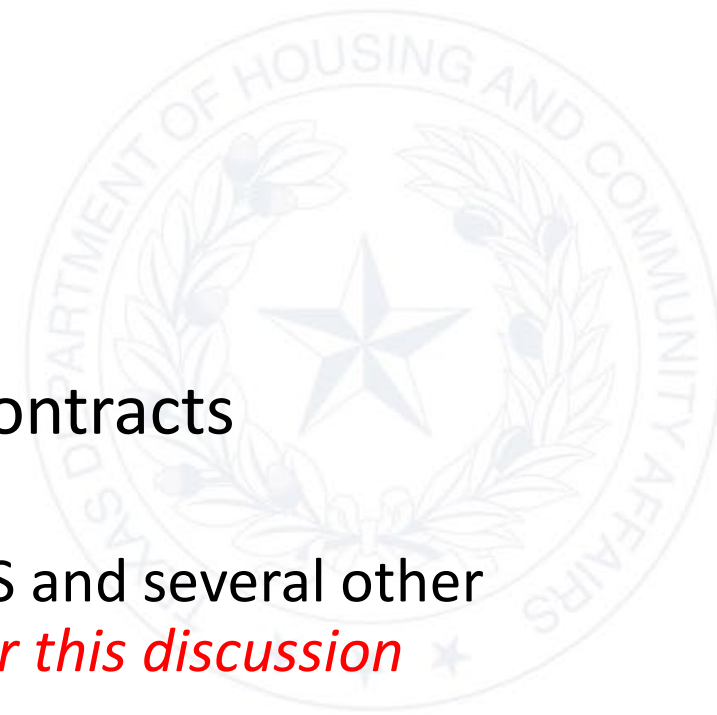

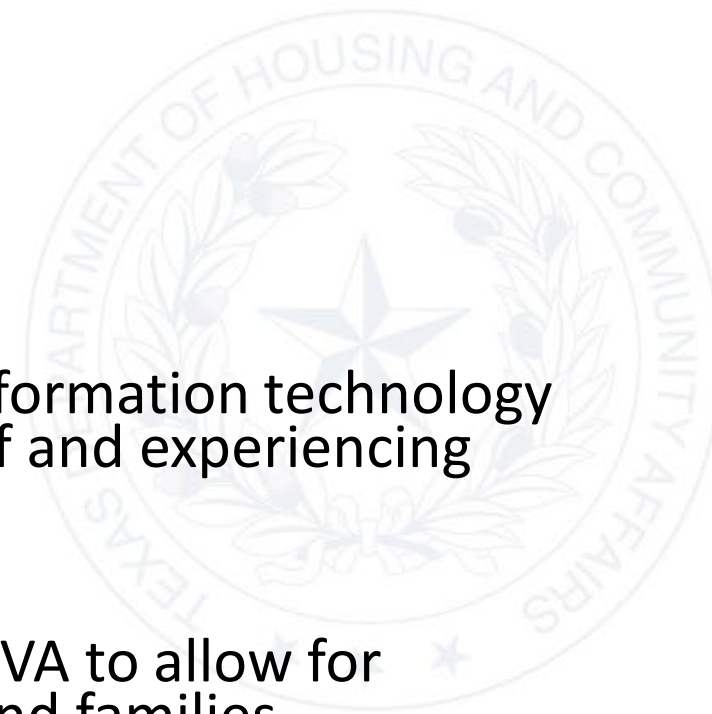

HSS Subrecipients

- There are currently 47 active ERA2 HSS Subrecipient contracts
 - Some HSS Subrecipients rely on HMIS to collect data for HSS and several other homelessness assistance programs. *←intended audience for this discussion*
 - For those HSS Subrecipients that do NOT use HMIS for data collection, continue reporting as usual.



HMIS Overview

- Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) is a local information technology system used to collect data for individuals and families at risk of and experiencing homelessness.
- HMIS data standards have been established HUD, HSS, and the VA to allow for standardized data collection across systems about individuals and families experiencing homelessness.
- Treasury funded programs like ERA HSS do not use HMIS data standards.
- FY 2024 HMIS Data Standards are effective as of October 1, 2023.

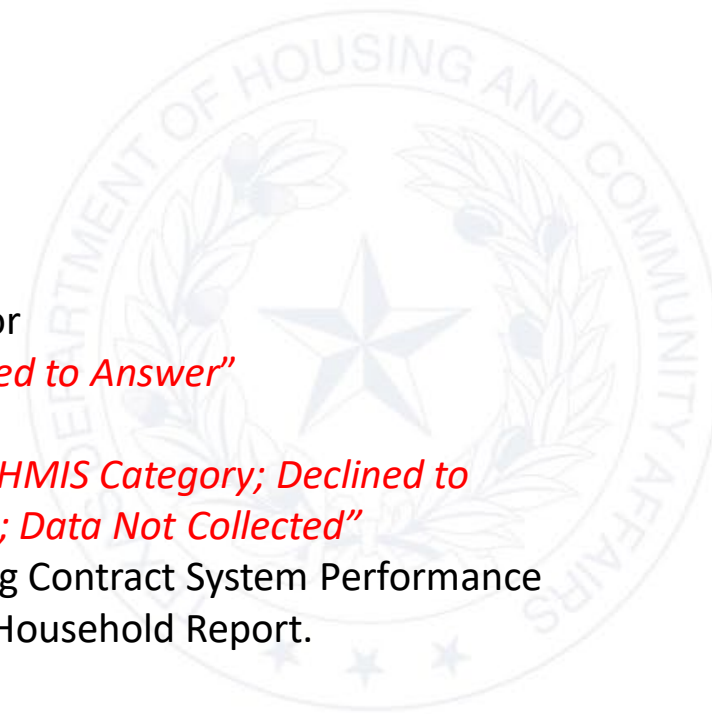

Selecting HSS Data Elements for Race and Ethnicity

HMIS Element Name		If a Household selects only one HMIS response , use this HSS data element:

- If a household selects more than one race, excluding Hispanic/Latina/e/o, use the HSS *“Other HMIS Category; Declined to Answer; Data Not Collected”* option and not the *“Multi-Racial/Other”* option.
- If a households selects one race and *“Hispanic/Latina/e/o”* in HMIS, enter that one race in the corresponding HSS Race of Household field and enter Hispanic or Latino in the HSS Ethnicity of Household field.
- The HSS option for *“Declined to Answer”* will be changed to *“Other HMIS Category; Declined to Answer; Data Not Collected”* in both the Housing Contract System Performance Report and in the Household Report.

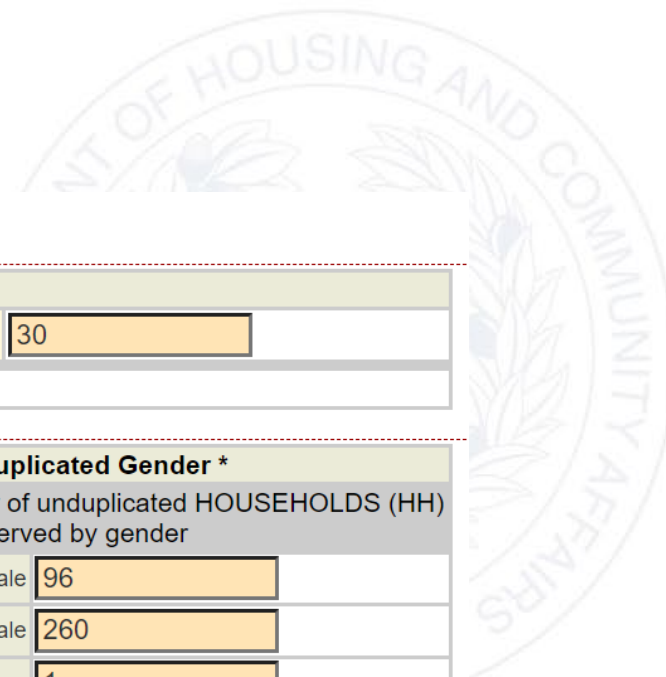

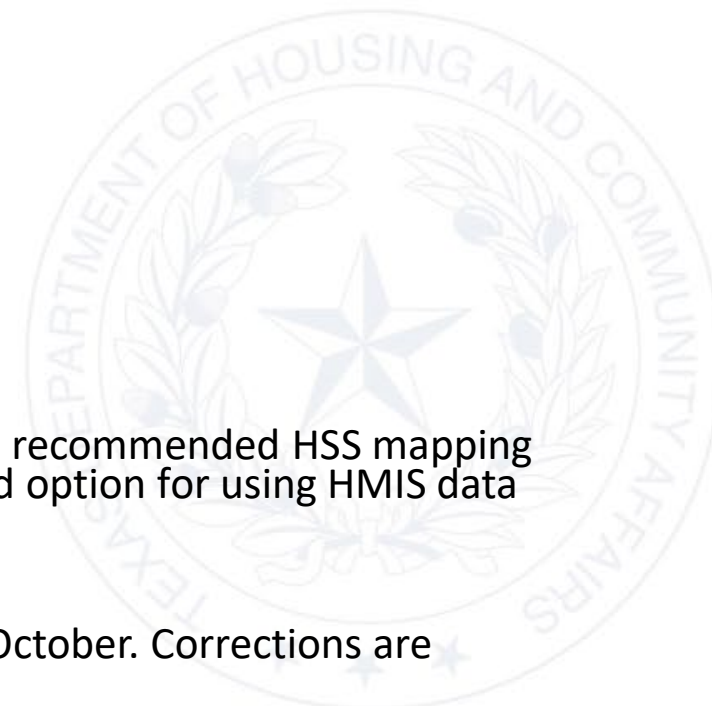

- Households reported must still be unduplicated. If mapping from HMIS, Ethnicity will only include “Hispanic or Latino” and “Other HMIS Category; Declined to Answer; Data Not Collected”
- The HSS option for “Declined to Answer” will be changed to “Other HMIS Category; Declined to Answer; Data Not Collected” in both the Housing Contract System Performance Report and in the Household Report.



Monthly Reporting

- When to start?
 - Subrecipients may choose to start reporting using new HMIS data standards and the recommended HSS mapping at any time. This is not a mandatory reporting requirement – simply a recommended option for using HMIS data to complete HSS Performance reporting.
- Corrections for October
 - Subrecipients *may* resubmit corrected Smartsheet Monthly Household Reports for October. Corrections are OPTIONAL.
 - Use the Corrections link at: <https://app.smartsheet.com/b/form/8610a0eb848e4a9080a612eb2c739f36>
 - No corrections will be needed for previously submitted Performance Reports in the Housing Contract System.
- Reporting going Forward
 - If you plan to map from HMIS, please keep consistent. Monthly unduplicated household data must continue to match in Housing Contract System and on the Smartsheet Monthly Household Report.
 - Note that the HSS option for “*Declined to Answer*” will be changed to “*Other HMIS Category; Declined to Answer; Data Not Collected*” in both the Housing Contract System Performance Report and in the Smartsheet Monthly Household Report.
