Dear PFC User/Operator:

The Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs (Department) received documentation on August 29, 2025, addressing the noncompliance identified during the review of the Audit Report submitted by Novogradac & Company LLP on June 2, 2025. Corrective action was due on September 9, 2025.

The documentation submitted was sufficient to correct the noncompliance related to **Failure to comply with the Public Facility Corporation Regulatory Agreement,** which requires one hundred two (102) units at 80% AMI, sixty-four (64) units at 60% AMI, and five (5) of the 60% AMI units to be reserved for or rented to and occupied by Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) holders. The corrections addressed findings related to **Households above the income limit** affecting units 1122, 1203, 1220, 1311, 1315, 3123, 3305, 3308, 4209, 7101, 7106, and 7208, as well as **Gross rent exceeding the highest rent allowed under the Regulatory Agreement** affecting units 1221, 3123, and 5112. Please see attached Finding Report for details.

The next Audit report is due June 1, 2026.
