JANUARY 2018 TICH MEETING REPORT

REVIEW OF PREVIOUS REPORTS:

- Surveyed 5 CoC's and Interviewed 3 CoC's to determine best sites to pilot enhanced coordination between local workforce boards and CoC's .
- Offered VISTAs to Austin/Travis County and Tarrant County CoC
- Signed MOU's and created Assignment Descriptions for prospective members
- VISTA members will
 - Create or Join the workforce committee at the CoC, preferably one that includes Work Force representatives
 - Create policy and procedure and a network for referrals between CoC and Work Force Boards; possibly find a way to include this in Coordinated Entry
 - Create or strengthen employer connections with providers
 - Develop an employment resource list for clients as well as a training for chronically unemployed clients and re-entering citizens


CURRENT PROGRESS

- Recruiting a little slower than hoped. Initially, we recruited for a January start date but did not find a good fit in that time frame.
- Found a candidate for Tarrant County, she will start April 23
- A few candidates will be interviewing with Austin ECHO this week and next; candidate will start in April







In 2015-16, Texas public schools enrolled 5.28 million students. One in every 50 of those students was homeless.
